Where is your Allegiance?

I know that this newsletter is very stout and I know that it is disturbing. It should be on all counts. First, as the scripture says, "Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves." (II Cor 13:5) Folks, our faith should be in Jesus

Christ and Him alone. If you are constantly challenging what Jesus said to accommodate your doctrine, then you are not following Jesus. You are following something else. It might be the teaching of some denomination or some dynamic preacher but it is poison if it **contradicts** Jesus! You cannot pick and choose only the things you like that Jesus said. What good is any unity that ignores the blood-red letters of Jesus Christ!?**

You'll be amazed at how much you'll understand and if you know any-

thing at all of the Spirit of God you will want to repent.

I'm not trying to be hard. I'm telling you the truth. Your allegiance needs to be to Jesus. He alone is worthy! See Him with me. In Rev 19 the Bible says:

And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteous-

ness he doth judge and make war. His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on his head were many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself. And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called The Word of God. And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean. And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. And he hath on his vesture and on his thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS. (Rev 19:11-16)
